

- 14 individuals and/or families were added to the BNL for the first time

- 1 individuals and/or families were updated as "Inactive" from "Active"

Note: The impact of few affordable housing options - with only 2.4% of the rental options affordable to households in the lowest 20% of income distribution, lowest vacancy rate of 1% and higher levels of rental arrears - correlates with marked increases to the number of households experiencing homelessness in 2023 and onward.
